

Citation by Publication Research Guide

Overview

This research guide includes information and resources on Citation by Publication. A request for Service of Citation by Publication can be used in a family case when the individual is unable to locate the other parent. It is also used in other types of civil cases. This process requires a judge's approval and may include the hiring of an Attorney Ad Litem to search for the other party at the litigant's expense.
