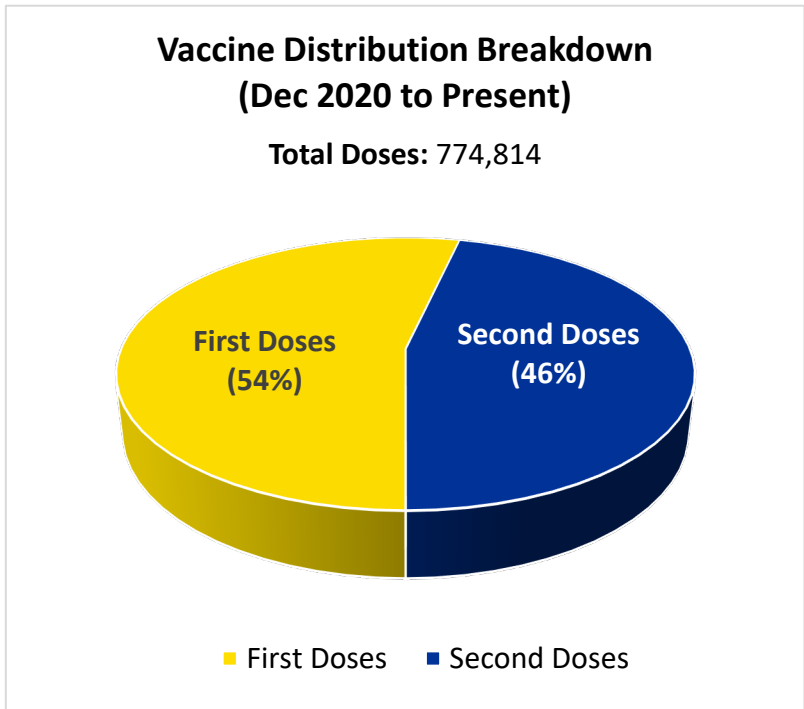
SUMMARY

The Tarrant County COVID-19 Recovery Report provides relevant programmatic data and information on COVID-related programs currently administered by the County including the **COVID-19 Vaccination Program**, the **Tarrant County Emergency Rental Assistance Program (ERAP)**, and the **Tarrant County Eviction Diversion Program**. Additional programmatic information will be provided as new programs are implemented. Information related to grant funding applications and awards is also provided herein. The Tarrant County COVID-19 Recovery Report is provided to the Commissioners Court and the public every Tuesday.

COVID-19 VACCINATION PROGRAM

Tarrant County's COVID-19 Vaccination Program has transitioned from centralized mass vaccination sites to mobile pop-up sites as the main distribution mechanism for COVID-19 vaccinations. In the section below, you will find tables and graphs to illustrate Tarrant County vaccination trends. See **Appendix B** for a breakdown of daily vaccination data and a schedule of pop-up sites. Since its inception at the end of December 2020, the County's vaccination efforts have produced the following results:

Figure 1. Table detailing the number of first, second, and total COVID-19 vaccine doses administered over the preceding four (4) weeks.

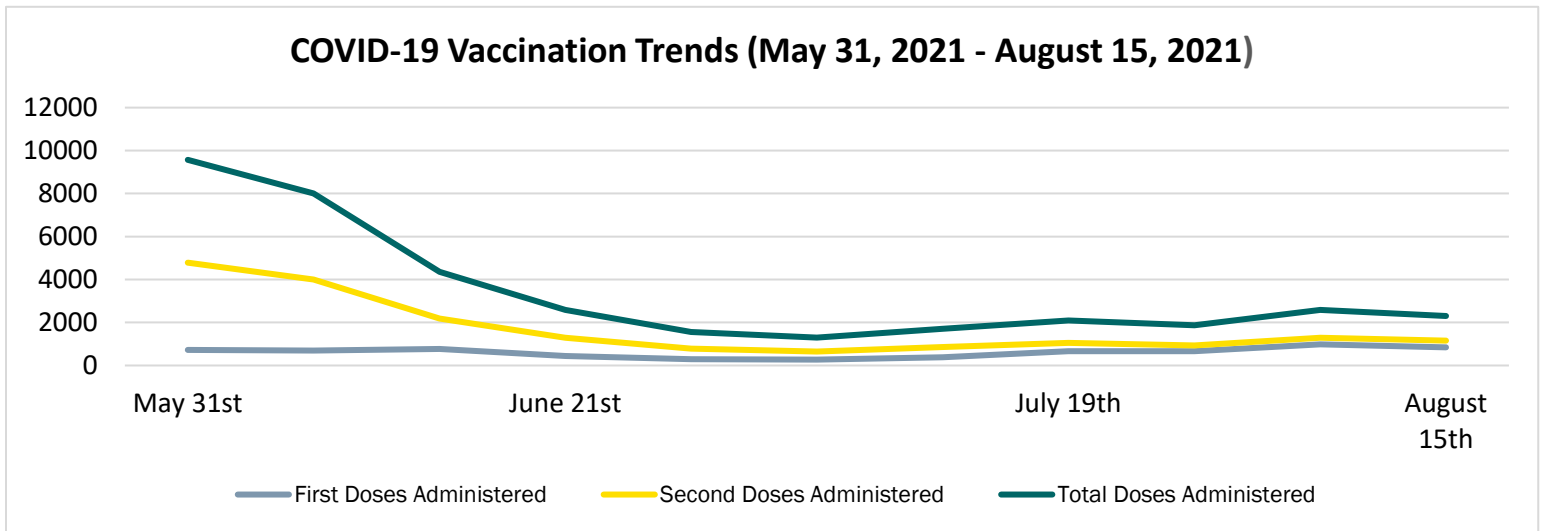


Figure 2. First dose, second dose, and total COVID-19 vaccination trends over the preceding three-month period.

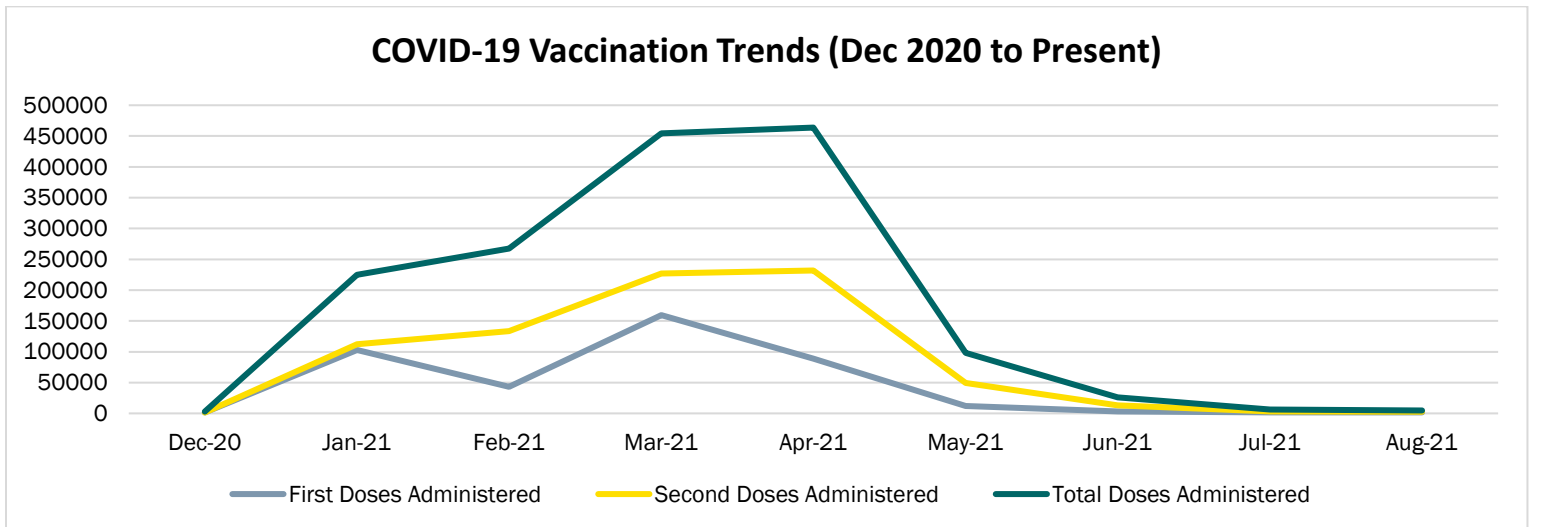


Figure 3. First dose, second dose, and total COVID-19 vaccination trends since the inception of the COVID-19 vaccination program.
