Re: Auditor's Report - Cash Counts for the Three Months Ending December 31, 2015

In accordance with Local Government Code, Sections 115.003 and 130.902, the Auditor's Office conducted 42 surprise cash counts totaling \$1,657,701 for the three months ending December 31, 2015 as follows:

As a result of our surprise cash counts, we found the following variances:

Sheriff's Inmate Trust Fund (Counterfeit bill collected 09/22/15)	(20.00)
Tax Office – Northeast Sub-Courthouse	0.45
Tax Office – Southlake Sub-Courthouse	0.70
Net Over / (Short)	(18.85)

The Tax Office differences were recorded to their Over/(Short) general ledger account. The Sheriff's Inmate Trust Fund shortages due to counterfeit bills are still pending.

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The Auditor's Office established a quarterly cash count schedule to perform surprise cash counts of funds held by County offices. There were 64 change funds totaling \$71,120 and eight petty cash funds totaling \$57,400 that were approved by Commissioners Court as of December 31, 2015. Furthermore, 36 locations accept cash and remittances without a change fund.

The objective of our review was to determine whether:

- Proper approval was awarded to new change/petty cash funds and to any changes made to the approved funds;
- Change/petty cash funds and remittances were accurately recorded and properly reconcile to the respective accounts; and
- Change funds were used only to make change in connection with collections payable to the County and were not used to make loans, advances, or to cash checks or warrants of any kind.
