About the Program

Tarrant County offers a home barrier removal program for Tarrant County residents living <u>outside</u> the boundaries of the Cities of Arlington, Fort Worth and Grand Prairie.


The home barrier removal program will remove ADA barriers and add ADA friendly features to improve living standards. This is funded through the Community Development Block Grant and the HOME Investment Partnership Program; Federal funds from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) administered by Tarrant County Community Development & Housing Department.



Income Limits (2022)

Your household income must fall below 80% of the Area Median Income (AMI) limit.

1 person < \$50,650. 5 persons < \$78,100. 2 persons < \$57,850. 6 persons < \$83,900. 3 persons < \$65,100. 7 persons < \$89,700. 4 persons < \$72,300. 8 persons < \$95,450.



Program Eligibility Requirements

To be eligible to participate in this program, you must meet the following qualifications:

- 1. Have an annual income below the HUD established income limits;

 AND
- 2.Own your home (place of residence for at least one year); *AND*
- Have no more than two liens placed against the property; AND
- Have proof of need for barrier removal;
 - a.SSI or equivalent based on disability; or
 - b.Letter from Doctor; AND
 - c. Physical inspection of home
