T.R.C.P. 510.7: JURY TRIAL DEMANDED FOR EVICTION

- Any party may file a written demand for a trial by jury by making a request to the court at least 3 business days before the trial date, excluding the day of filing.
- The demand must be accompanied by payment of a jury fee (\$22.00) or by filing a sworn statement of inability to afford payment of court cost for jury fee.
- If no jury is timely demanded by either party, the judge will try the case.

If you demand a jury trial and fail to appear for trial, the Justice Court may order you to pay the cost incurred for impaneling the jury according to Civil Practice & Remedies Code 30.008. The Justice Court may release a party from this obligation to pay costs at a hearing to show good cause for failure to appear.

Note: A request for the cancellation of a jury trial in Justice Court, Precinct Four must be received at least 72 hours prior to the jury trial date.
