

## Login Help

eResponse is a service that has been designed to allow all prospective jurors to complete an online juror questionnaire which will assist in claiming exemptions, disqualifications or deferring service to a later date. You will be required to supply an email address and a telephone number when filling in the questionnaire.

To login to eResponse, you will need several pieces of information:

- Your **Candidate ID** is the same as your 10-digit “Juror No.” and can be found on your summons near any of the barcodes or next to the words “JUROR NO.”
- Your **PIN #** is located on both the top and bottom sections of the summons. **The alphanumeric PIN # is case sensitive so make sure all letters are capitalized.**
- You will also need to enter your **Date of Birth** as it appears on the top section beneath the time, date and place to appear.
- Finally, you will need to check the box that states you swear or affirm that you are telling the truth about your qualifications or exemptions from jury service.

All of the information you are providing will be sent to the court. *Please note that in addition to any criminal penalty prescribed by law, a person who does not comply with the summons as required by law or who knowingly provides false information in a request for an exemption or to be excused from jury service is subject to a contempt action punishable by a fine of not less than \$100 nor more than \$1000. Texas Government Code Section 62.0141.*
