PROGRAM STATUS

The second round of the **Small Business Assistance Program** review is complete.

The County has **6 COVID-19 Testing Sites** in partnerships with the City of Arlington, City of North Richland Hills, City of Fort Worth, City of Azle and Arlington Independent School District. The County has started the administration of **COVID-19 Vaccinations**.

The **Rental Assistance Program** application window is closed. Staff is processing remaining applications received by December 9th. Agreements with two non-profits for Rental Assistance were approved 12/15.

The **NGO Assistance Program** has approved 79 awards equaling about \$8.2 million in Tarrant County CRF Funds.

Local Partners include Chambers of Commerce, Volunteer Fire Departments, Tarrant County 911 District and MHMR Tarrant County.

Municipal Distributions are complete with 39 cities receiving CRF Funds.

SMALL BUSINESS ASSISTANCE
