IMPORTANT NOTICE

Effective Monday, July 1, 2019, Justice Court Precinct One will implement **MANDATORY** E-Filing of ALL cases. Paper case filings will **no longer be accepted** after July 1, 2019.

On May 16, 2019, the Court officially designated all Court documents as the official Court record. Since November 2018, over 6 months ago, multiple notices have been posted throughout the 1895 Old Courthouse, 100 W. Weatherford St. and in Justice Court Precinct One, Room 450. Also, a notice was posted on the Court's website as to the July 1st implementation.

All Pro Se litigants (parties not represented by an attorney) and attorneys will be **required** to submit new Eviction, Small Claims, Debt Claims, any subsequent case filings and any other response pleadings via E-File Texas Self-Help or E-File Texas. Any litigant not having online computer capabilities will have access to the computer kiosk in the Justice Court office. Any cases not accepted by E-File Texas Self-Help or E-File Texas will have to be submitted **in person**.
