EXECUTIVE ORDER OF COUNTY JUDGE B. GLEN WHITLEY

WHEREAS, I, B. Glen Whitley, County Judge of Tarrant County, Texas, issued an Executive Order on June 25, 2020, and becoming effective on June 26, 2020, requiring, among other things, all entities providing goods and services to the public in Tarrant County to develop and implement a health and safety policy requiring all employees and visitors to wear face coverings; and


WHEREAS, Tarrant County entities must post the health and safety policy in a conspicuous location within five (5) calendar days following the effective date of the June 25, 2020, Executive Order; and

WHEREAS, the next scheduled meeting of the Tarrant County Commissioners Court is on July 7, 2020, which is eleven (11) days after the effective date of the June 25, 2020, Executive Order; and

THEREFORE, pursuant to Texas Government Code Chapter 418 and the Texas Disaster Act of 1975, and to be in compliance with my June 25, 2020, Executive Order, be It Proclaimed and **ORDERED** by the County Judge that effective upon the date that my signature is affixed and lasting until 6:00 p.m. on July 7, 2020, unless adopted or modified by the Tarrant County Commissioners Court, Tarrant County shall:

1. Implement the attached Health and Safety Policy for Tarrant County Buildings and Facilities and post it in a conspicuous location to provide notice to the public.
