



Arbovirus Final Surveillance Report
MMWR Week Aug 29-Sep 4, 2021

Week 35 Summary

- 185 mosquito pools* have been tested in NTRL from week 35
 - Year-to-date NTRL has tested a total of 3283 mosquito pools
- 32 mosquito pools tested positive for WNV this week:
 - Arlington (1) Burleson* (4) Colleyville (1) Crowley (4) Euless (1) Fort Worth* (7) Grapevine (1) Grand Prairie* (2) Hurst (2) Keller (1) Mansfield (3) North Richland Hills (1) Southlake (2) Unincorporated (2)
- There has been 1 imported human case of Dengue, and 0 cases of SLE or Zika in 2021.
 - There has been 2 human cases of West Nile disease.
- Average number of mosquitoes/trap include:
 - *Culex* spp: 48.1
 - *Aedes aegypti*: 11.2
 - *Aedes albopictus* 7.5

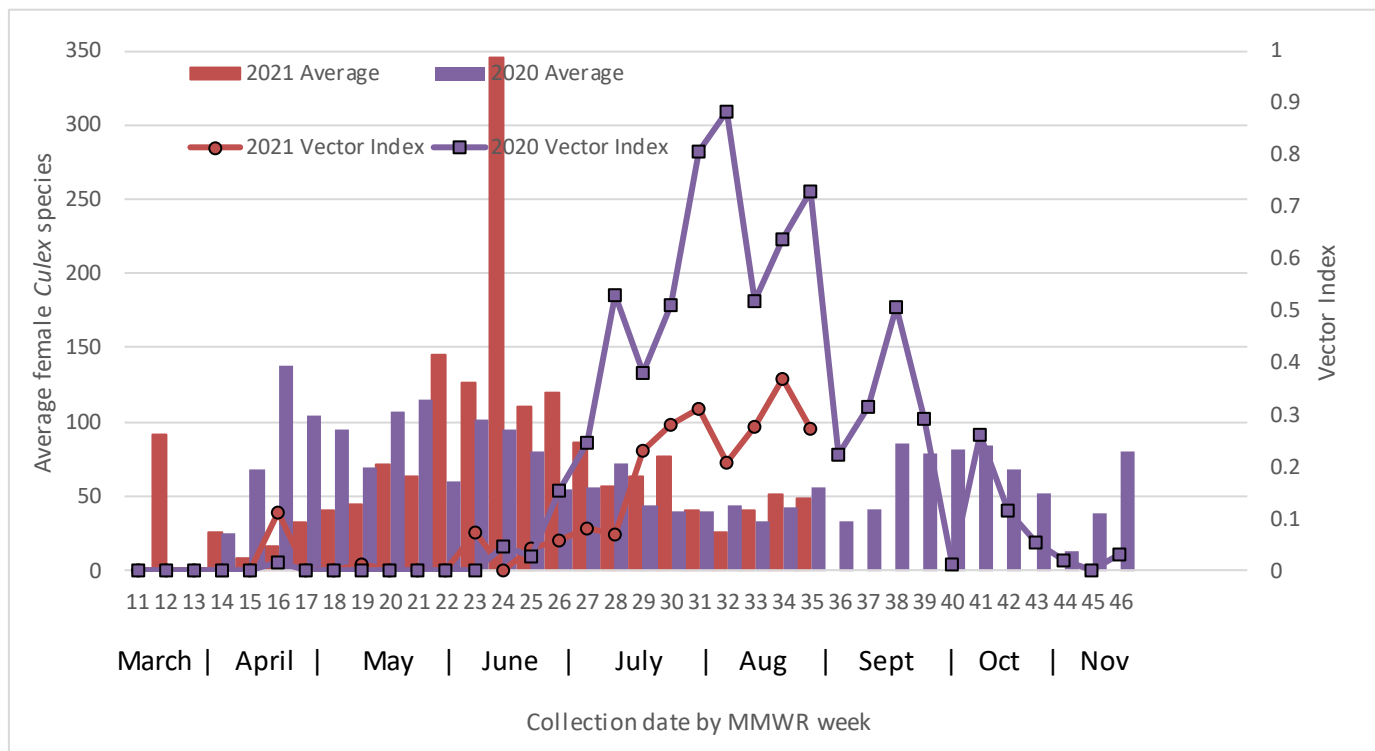

Figure 1. Average Number of Female *Culex* Species Per Trap and Vector Index by Collection Date, Tarrant County, 2020-2021

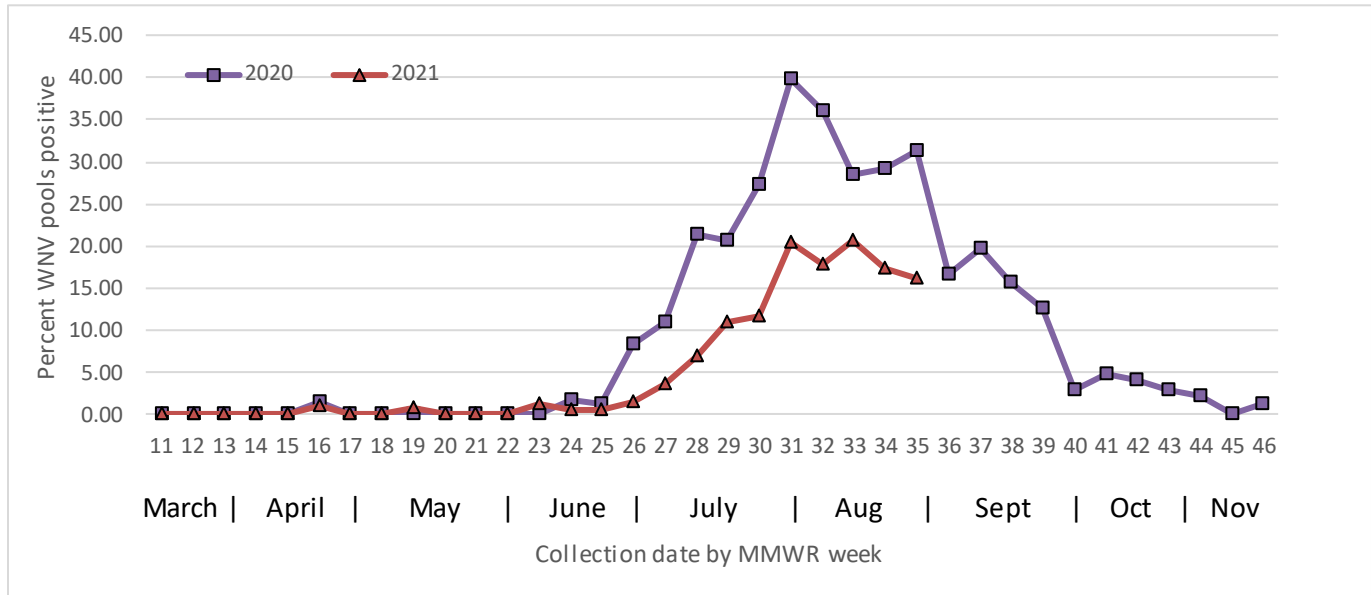
